(Winter Term – January 1, 2022 thru June 30, 2022)

Program:

The program is designed to offer an opportunity to gain training and experience for individuals who have completed an accredited Fire Academy or possess a Firefighter 1 Certification. In addition, this program assists individuals to meet a large portion of their FF II Task Book requirement pertaining to the "Experience" component required from State Fire Training. Selected candidates will be assigned to a 48/96 shift for a term of six-months. Intern firefighters receive a \$50.00 meal stipend per shift. Firefighter Intern is a temporary, unpaid, non-benefited position.

Application Period:

Applications will be accepted at the Nevada County Consolidated Fire District (NCCFD) located at 640 Coyote Street, Nevada City, CA 95959. The acceptance of applications will begin on Monday, November 1, 2021 to Thursday, December 2, 2021. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 08:00 to 17:00. Applications may be submitted in person or online. Please visit www.nccfire.com for the job description and application.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Valid EMT & CPR certifications
- 18 years of age
- High School Diploma or GED equivalent
- Valid California Driver's License with clean driving history
- Satisfactory enrollment in a California State Fire Marshal Firefighter I or II Accredited Academy with successful completion by appointment date.

The application packet must include the following:

1. Completed, signed NCCFD Job Application.
2. A current/valid California Driver's License and DMV driving record dated within 30 days of application.
3. A copy of current/valid EMT and CPR cards.
4. Proof of current TB test, Hepatitis B series or currently in-process of TB testing or Hepatitis B vaccinations.
5. Proof of Medical Physical within 6 months (academy physical may be used).
6. Satisfactory enrollment in or successful completion of a California State Fire Marshal Firefighter I or II accredited academy.
7. Copy of high school diploma or GED equivalent.
8. Resume.
